Education – CTE/STEM programs, scholarships, pathways to college and career, improved academic outcomes in grade 6-12

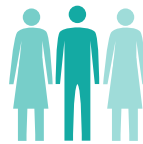
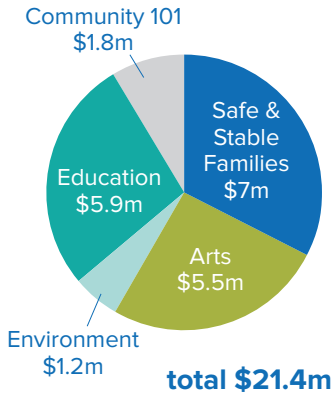


Arts Education – arts integrated into school curriculum, access to arts experiences

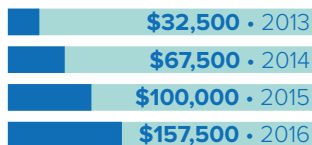
